

Yearly planner for PSHE curriculum

Our new PSHE curriculum is offering a fresh, exciting and relevant approach to develop the children's journey with their bodies and environment in the 21st century. The lesson headings have been sorted into the terms that they will be taught to the children and teachers will remind you again of the termly content in their specific year group termly information plans. Our school ethos is to nurture the children with the collaboration and support of parents, carers and families and you can do this by logging onto the scheme that we use. The scheme is called 'Life to the Full' by the company TenTen and is the sister scheme to a Religious scheme that we also use in Collective Worship sessions. On the parent portal for the scheme you can read a brief synopsis about each lesson that your child will engage in during the year. The sessions in school will be delivered via videos, role play, group and partner discussions, artwork, written work and singing in the future (covid permitting). Parents/Carers can support their children further by discussing the content of the sessions at home or preparing them in advance.

There is one session that **Year 6** children can be withdrawn from and that is:

Making babies. Part 2 (taught in the Spring term).

This lesson can be withdrawn from as it falls under the Sex Education curriculum which our school has decided to include and Sex Education is individual choice at Primary level and not Statutory.

Every other lesson, including puberty and online safety falls under the Health Curriculum and this is statutory so children cannot legally be withdrawn from these sessions.

Attached is the official guidance from the Department for Education that presents the legal obligations for the school to embrace.

If you wish for your year 6 child to be withdrawn from that particular lesson please inform the relevant teacher and Ms Moyse via the school office. For that session alone, your child will be taught another activity with a member of staff.
